HOSPITALITY RIDER

This rider is attached to and made part of the agreement between **Victor James Chapman** (FULL BAND/ DUO/SOLO) (herein referred to as "Artist") and _____ (herein referred to as "Venue" or "Buyer") for performance on _____ 201__

Your cooperation in meeting the guidelines found within this agreement is appreciated to help insure the Venue, Artist and Audience the best possible experience. Should you have any problems in fulfilling this rider, please contact Manager/ Booking agent.

General Terms:

Stage - Artists need room to move. If the stage is too small, then Artist just looks silly standing there. The stage shouldn't break or collapse during a performance. There should be no holes or other liabilities in, on, or around the stage.

Security - Buyer shall guarantee proper security at all times to ensure the safety and privacy of Artist, Artist crew and guests, all equipment, and personal property from the beginning of load-in until the completion of load-out. Buyer will be held financially responsible for any loss due to lack of proper security.

Taping and Cameras ARE allowed. Video and Broadcasting of any sort, in any medium may be allowed only with Artist's prior consent. Please advance this issue with Tour Manager. Artist retains the non-negotiable right to record (audio or video) their performance or have it recorded for them, free of charge or limitation. Artist shall use their own recording gear if allowing a patch into the board poses a production issue for Buyer. This recording is the exclusive property of Artist, and Buyer shall not restrict or inhibit this activity in any way unless a request to do so is made when the contract and rider link are received by buyer.

Billing and advertising - Artists' name must appear with the appropriate billing in all printed advertising and must be mentioned in all radio spots. Billing is as follows: **Victor James Chapman**

Complimentary tickets - A minimum of 8 complimentary tickets may be requested by Artist, unless stipulated otherwise by the terms of the Contract. These tickets or guest list spots are generally for street teamers, as well as friends, and we ask that you honor this that we may best promote our date with you.

Management also reserves the right to request 5 additional complimentary tickets for Media or VIP guests.

Tour Manager shall have reasonable access to the box office or ticketing area and shall be provided with verifiable ticket sales or attendance counts upon request.

Merchandise - Artist will be provided a lighted space and a table to display and sell merchandise. This space must be adequate table and have an electrical outlet accessible for a lamp, etc.

Unless stipulated otherwise in the Contract, Artist will sell all merchandise and retain all proceeds.

Parking - Well-lit, FREE parking for one (2) vehicle must be provided in close proximity to venue and must be available from load-in to load-out.
